Description of Event: Cub-o-ree is a weekend outdoor camping event for Cub Scouts and their families. Camping is possible on Friday and Saturday nights. Saturday, Cubs will rotate among different stations that deal with fun stuff (for example: regatta, games, wrist rockets, Texas Badge to name a few). There will be a campfire at the conclusion of activities on Saturday evening. Newly registered Cubs who received a rocket will have the opportunity to launch it. If you don't want to camp come out for Saturday's fun.

Who does the Program Benefit: The Cub-o-ree program is designed for all Cubs. Siblings are welcome to camp and participate but preferences on rotations are reserved for scouts. **Each participant must be accompanied by a Parent.**

Campers will be responsible for their own camping equipment, food, and transportation.

Registration: Online via the Doubleknot system **ONLY**. We will not be processing walkups. **All attendees** will need to turn in a completed BSA Health Form (parts A & B) either at roundtable on October 13th or onsite at Cub-o-ree. The completed health form **must** include a copy of the attendee's health insurance card.

Cost of Event: Event registration is \$10 for all scouts and siblings who want to participate in the activities. Adults and children who will not be participating in the activities are free.
